# University of Northern Colorado-Taiwan Scholarships

The University of Northern Colorado is pleased to announce two scholarships for students and faculty from Taiwan:

### \$10,000 Student Scholarship - \*\*NEW\*\*

- Each student will be awarded US\$5,000 each year for two years...
- Intensive English studies can also be paid for with this scholarship.
- This may not be combined with an assistantship

These awards will go to a maximum of two students each year from UNC's sister universities in Taiwan. These students:

- ✓ May be at the Bachelor, Masters, or Doctoral level
- ✓ Must be accepted to UNC as a full-time, degree-seeking student
- ✓ Will be nominated by the President of their home university
- ✓ Will have a minimum GPA of 3.0 after conversion into the U.S. scale
- √ Will have been accepted to the department of their major (for Masters and Doctoral level students)
  prior to consideration for this scholarship. This requirement does not apply to undergraduate
  students.
  - Undergraduate students will have a minimum TOEFL score of 200 (CBT)
  - All graduate students will have a minimum TOEFL score of 220 (CBT)
  - Doctoral students must present scores of at least 400 on both the verbal and quantitative sections of the GRE-General Test with a combined score of at least 1000 and an analytical writing score of at least 3.5.

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Interested students should submit to Dr. Allen Huang, the Proyost at UNC:

- 1. A letter asking to be considered for the award.
- 2. A letter of recommendation from the president of the student's current or most recent university.
- 3. Official copies of TOEFL score and (if required) GRE score should go to the Office of International Admissions during the application process. These will be copied and included with the student's scholarship application.

#### UNC - Taiwan Exchange Scholar Award:

## **Applicants**

- will be nominated by the president of their university to the president of UNC
- ✓ will receive an award of US\$13,500 each year for two years
- ✓ will be employed as faculty of UNC's sister universities the year of their application
- ✓ will study at UNC for the terminal degree in their professional area

Application Deadline for both scholarships is May 15th for the 2005-2006 academic year,
