AGREEMENT OF CO-OPERATION

between

LATROBE UNIVERSITY IN AUSTRALIA

and

NATIONAL HUALIEN TEACHERS COLLEGE, TAIWAN

This document constitutes an agreement between La Trobe University in Australia and the National Hualien Teachers College, Taiwan (herein referred to as "the two institutions") to engage in a program of co-operation.

- The two institutions agree to promote exchange and co-operation in all academic areas of research and teaching, including the sciences, technology, the humanities and social sciences, the development of new areas of research and teaching, and the sharing and dissemination of information and documentation in all areas of mutual interest.
- 2 The two institutions agree to facilitate exchange of and co-operation between the staff of both institutions in research, publication, teaching, supervision and examination of students, mounting of conferences, seminars and other areas of mutual interest.
- 3 The two institutions agree to facilitate the exchange of students wanting to visit and/or participate in the education programs of each institution.
- 4 Specific activities, projects, programs, relevant funding and other matters relating to the implementation of this Agreement shall be negotiated and dealt with separately.
- In order to ensure the good management of this Agreement, each participating institution shall appoint a person within it to be in charge of the day-to-day operation of this program.
- 6 This Agreement shall be effective for five years from the date of signing in the first instance, and shall be subject to change, renewal and termination by mutual consent.
