

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE  
University of Northern Colorado  
and  
National Hualien Teachers' College  
2003-2008

The University of Northern Colorado, Greeley Colorado, USA, and National Hualien Teachers' College (NHTC), Hualien, Taiwan, being in agreement that an international linkage agreement between the two universities is a mutually desirable objective, affirm their intent to cooperate fully to implement such a linkage. The two universities plan to develop a program of collaboration as follows:

**Program for Students**

UNC and NHTC will seek to develop an exchange program for students from both universities that are desirous of studying abroad. Such exchanges can take place at the undergraduate or graduate levels, irrespective of students' major field of study or colleges.

**Opportunities for Faculty**

Both parties to the agreement will seek to provide opportunities for faculty from the Arts and Sciences, Education, Performing Arts, Health and Human Sciences, and Business to visit as guest lecturers and to undertake programs of collaborative research.

**Other Areas of Collaboration**

Both parties agree to seek other areas of cooperation for the joint education and cultural exchange of their faculty and students.

**Procedures of Implementation**

This Agreement forms the general understanding between the two parties. Specific procedures and policies to enact elements of the agreement may be defined as an exchange of letters or codicil.

**Administrative Management**


The Office of International Affairs or its equivalent office at each university will coordinate the exchange activity for this linkage.
